• Student Led Clubs

We're excited to launch our Student-Led Clubs program again this year. It is a great way for students to explore their interests, develop leadership skills, and help build a strong school community! Students in Grades 4 and 5 can apply to lead a club, while Grade 3 students can apply as Leaders in Training, assisting and learning alongside the club leaders. Each club will have a staff advisor to provide support and guidance. We'll have two sessions this year - a fall and a winter session with half of the clubs running in each. Students in Grades K-4 will be able to sign up for clubs that interest them. Clubs will meet once a week during the noon outdoor playtime, and student leaders will be responsible for planning activities and organizing any needed supplies. Applications will be handed out on Monday and are due back by Friday. Clubs will begin the week of November 17th. We can't wait to see our students' creativity and leadership shine!

• ACCELERATE Workshop – December 5th (Parent Teacher Day)

Vision Coaching and KV Oasis are partnering to offer ACCELERATE — a fun and engaging one-day (4-hour) program that combines movement activities with interactive lessons on leadership, communication, teamwork, and self-confidence.
