This fun-filled event will bring together golfers, local businesses, and community members for a day of connection and friendly competition, all while raising funds to ensure the playground remains safe and accessible for future generations. - We are pleased to share that there will be a **Year 2 of the provincial calendar pilot**. As soon as I receive the updated calendar, I will share it with you. The additional days this year have been invaluable in building teacher and EA capacity through targeted professional learning aligned with our school priorities. They have also provided opportunities for classroom teachers, resource teachers, and EAs to collaboratively review data and plan for the diverse needs of our students. In addition, these days have allowed teachers to work together in their PLCs, as well as individually, to support improved outcomes for all students. The Department of Education has engaged DataNB to review both qualitative and quantitative data related to this initiative, which was implemented province-wide in the Francophone sector three years ago.
- Reminder: **Morning Supervision and Student Safety** We are noticing an increasing number of students arriving at school and going onto the playground before 7:45 a.m. Please be reminded that there is no supervision in place before 7:45, and students should not be on school grounds prior to that time.
